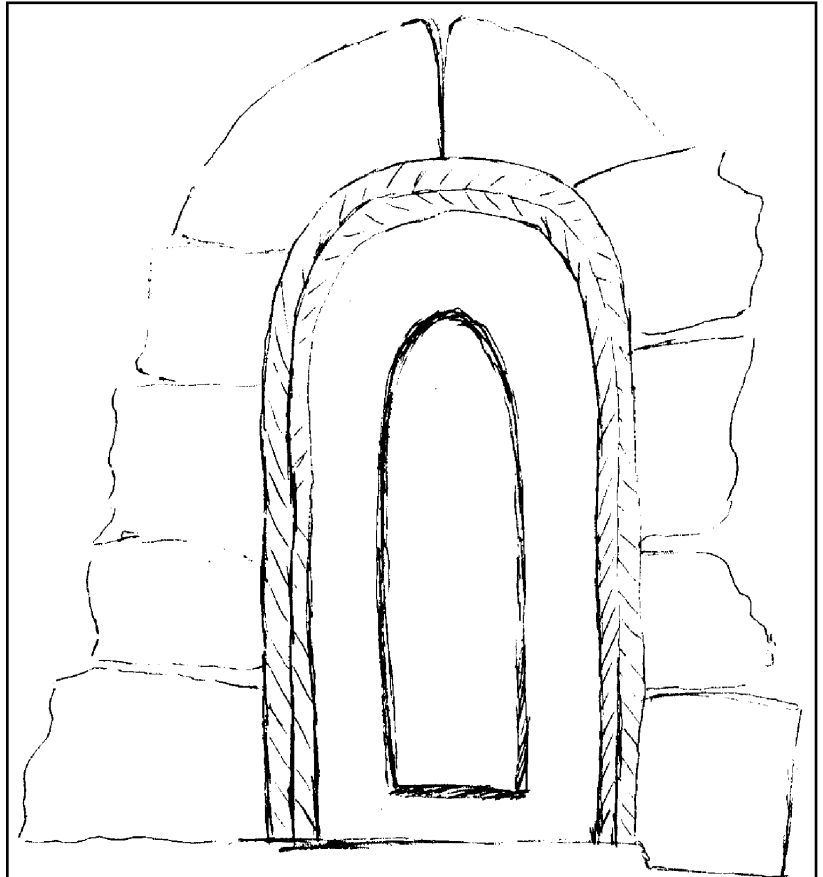
This lies between Fareham and Wickham but is best approached from Fareham. There are about three Boarhunts; the one with the Saxon church is the one nearest Fareham and is, I think, North Boarhunt. It is open rarely – Sundays only – and is set back some way from the Road. As it wasn't Sunday I wasn't able to get in, but according to N. O'Dell's *Hampshire & Dorset's Churches* the fabric dates from the reign of Edward the Confessor.

N.B. Tall chancel arch, 7 wide; pil. strip on I end.

Font

The font is Saxon but has been restored; so too is the blocked window with decorated cable moulding.
