Exterior S wall entirely covered with modern plaster.

Exterior N wall has coursed rubble walls of mixed flint and stone, also partially obscured by plaster.

Remains of round-head N doorway. E impost of slab type, projecting, much weathered. Arch-head of roughly shaped square stones with remains of corbel at crown. W impost and jambs destroyed. Doorway filled with modern brick. Remains of arch-head supported on timber beam.
