Interior

Original N wall of nave over E pier of N arcade has Anglo-Saxon blocked opening. E jamb remains of upright-and-flat Round-head of roughly segmented stones. Top flat stone of jambs acts as impost

Exterior

Original nave N wall, now N aisle, over arcade, has row of gable-head blind arcading of rough-cut stones. Arches about 1' high to springings. Line of arcade broken by exterior of round-head window with arch-head of single lintel stone shaped to round-head on lower side but straight on top: shows window to have been widely splayed.

Marks of original gabled E end of nave visible on present wall springing from base of present clerestorey.
