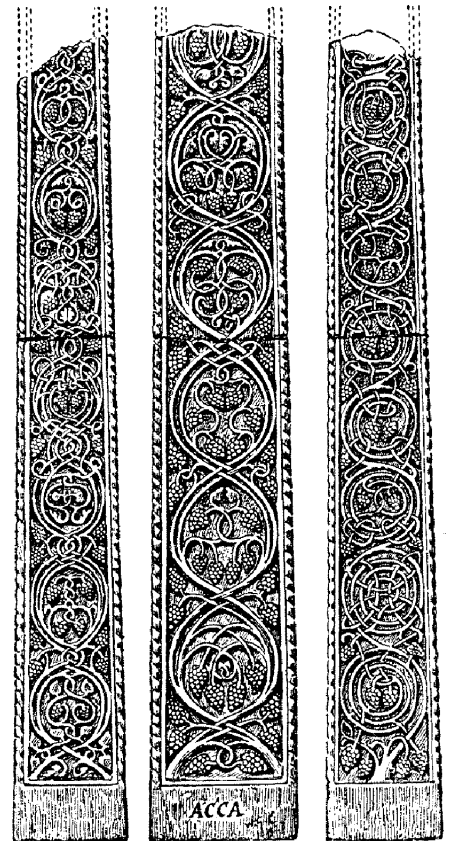
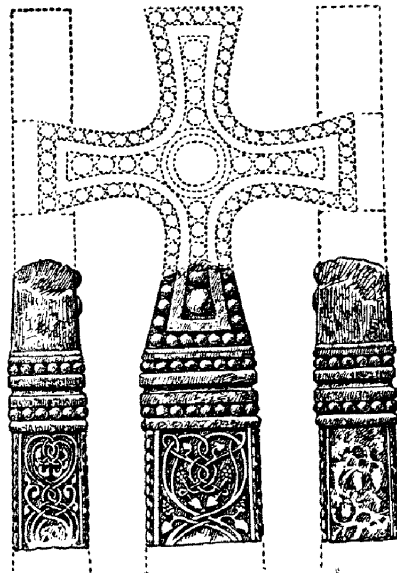
Cross Shafts
