Crosses

1. In middle of chancel on an iron frame. C10 Anglo-Danish.
2. Carved C9 cross on tower W face exterior below first string course and herringbone masonry.
3. C10 wheel-head cross over belfry opening on exterior of tower S face, 3' from the top.
