Two sections of cross-shaft</p> <p>Key to plan</p> <p>1 Blocked and partially destroyed Anglo-Saxon windows over post-Norman arcade</p>	<p>2 Blocked complete Anglo-Saxon window</p> <p>3 Single jambs of blocked and partially destroyed windows</p> <p>4 Upper parts of jambs and complete head of blocked Anglo-Saxon doorway above post-Norman South doorway</p> <p>5 Complete window in use and similar window at first-floor level</p> <p>6 Complete doorway, in use</p> <p>7 Norman arch with Anglo-Saxon window at first floor level</p> <p>8 Anglo-Saxon chancel arch</p>
