Round tower probably Anglo-Saxon but possibly only at base. Nave wall and probably about 10'-12' of chancel wall East of chancel arch.

Fisher

Round West tower and nave wall - period C3.

Taylor

Top of tower and parapet of brick and stonework probably Tudor.
