Small relics

An item of outstanding importance on display in the museum is this square-headed brooch of gilded bronze, set with garnets and cornelian and decorated with intertwined animal forms, excavated from the C6 Anglo-Saxon cemetery at Alveston Manor, Stratford-upon-Avon.

Other finds from this site include a decorated drinking vessel, an armband and combs of bone, necklaces of amber, glass and gaily decorated paste beads.
