Location

In centre of village turn North off East-West road up minor road with free-standing wooden fingerpost "centenary way". The church is less than 100 yards on E side. Plan of church on wall opposite font.

Date

South wall of nave – possibly period C.

Notes

Place name possibly means "painting", perhaps referring to a mural. [Earliest form Teurinctune, Domesday Book. Ekwall, *C O D of English Place-Names*, says first element is connected with OE *teorpan* 'to paint' and might be OE *teorping* 'painting'. If so, a mural painting or the like might be referred to. Cf, however, TEVERSALL etc, where it is suggested that OE *teorpan* may have meant also 'to practise sorcery'.]
